Use of old unused Light Motor Vehicles/Heavy Motor Vehicles of different Government offices/Agencies/PSUs of the State by the Govt. ITIs/ Polytechnics/ Diploma Institutes of the State.

Madam/Sir,

Inviting reference to the subject mentioned above, I am to say that provision for use of old unused Light Motor Vehicles/Heavy Motor Vehicles of different Government offices/Agencies/PSUs of the State by the Govt. ITIs/ Polytechnics/ Diploma Institutes of the State for training purpose was under active consideration of the Government for some time past as these vehicles fetch very little price during the auction. It would be more beneficial, if the same could be utilized by the local Govt. ITIs/Polytechnics/Diploma Institutes for practical training purposes of students.

Now Government have been pleased to decide that the Govt. ITIs/ Polytechnics/ Diploma Institutes of the State imparting courses in trades like Automobile, Mechanical and Mechanic Motor Vehicle etc. can procure the condemned vehicles of Government offices/Agencies/PSUs for practical training of the students at the offset price fixed by the Motor Vehicle Inspector.

The appropriate authority shall offer the said vehicles to the local Govt. ITIs/Polytechnics/Diploma Institutes as a first option to be used for practical training of the students. If the concerned ITIs/Polytechnics do not take the said vehicles within 30 days of the said offer, then the appropriate authority will go for tender/auction process.

This has been concurred in by Finance Department in relaxation of the existing Rule-23 of Rules Regulating Control & Use of Government Vehicles in their File No. **FIN-ES3-MV-0001-2020**.


