NOTIFICATION

No. 5032-LC-TR-66/2015/T.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 67 of the M.V. Act, 1988 (59 of 1988) and having regard to the provisions of clauses (a) to (d) of the said sub-section, the State Government do hereby issue the following directions to the State Transport Authority and the Regional Transport Authorities, Angul, Jajpur, Keonjhar, Sundargarh & Jagatsinghpur, namely:—

DIRECTIONS

The freight rates for mineral carrying goods carriages plying within and outside the districts of Angul, Jajpur, Keonjhar, Sundargarh & Jagatsinghpur shall be fixed as specified in the schedule given below from the date of issue of this Notification.

SCHEDULE

NOTE

1. For unloading of vehicles within 24 hours of reporting and any delay thereafter is to be compensated by the Consigner/ Consignee.
2. The Director, Mines may ensure that preferably locally moving vehicles would be facilitated to carry three trips so that the vehicles cover a minimum distance of 100 KMs per day.
